### **EPA** general meeting

The EPA general meeting 2011 is scheduled for Friday September 16, 2011 from 14.30 to 16.30 on the final day of the EPA congress in the Madrid Hall of Lingotto Conference Centre in Turin, Italy.

#### **Elections for President, Board and Policy and Strategy Committee**

There will be elections for several positions in the board of EPA. The position of EPA president and the two seats that are currently held by Laurence A. Bannerman and Antoni Roig will all be regularly elected for a term of office of two years each. Furthermore one position in the board will be elected for one year, as replacement for the seat that was held by Philippe Princet who has retired from the board with effect from the beginning of 2011. Also the six members of the Policy and Strategy Committee will be elected. Reelection is possible for all positions.

#### **Nomination procedure**

Candidates for any position need to be nominated by their national association. The deadline for nomination addressed to the EPA Secretariat is August 19, 2011. Nomination is also required for candidates who stand for reelection. Please specify clearly for which position the candidate is nominated, for example if a board candidate is nominated for the president's position or for board member.

The election for the board will take place first. If there are more nominations than board members a person who is not elected into the board may subsequently stand for the post of P&S Committee member, but only if he or she has been nominated previously. One candidate can be nominated for election both for the EPA board and for the Policy and Strategy Committee.

#### **Registration of Delegate**

All national parking associations that are full members of the EPA need to register their delegate entitled to vote in the election at the Secretariat.

## **EPA Congress 2011**

The scientific programme of the EPA congress 2011 in Turin, Italy is structured in four themes: Perception, Technology, Management, Economics. It has been prepared by an international and interdisciplinary expert committee. Key Note Speakers include reknown experts like Donald Shoup from Los Angeles, author of "The High Cost of Free Parking". Parallel workshop sessions and the EPA Award ceremony are also part of the conference program.

### EPA and POLIS parking workshop on May 17, 2011

The role of parking in Sustainable Urban Transport Plans was the theme of the EPA POLIS Parking Workshop on May 17<sup>th</sup> 2011 in Stuttgart, Germany. More than 30 delegates followed the variety of presentations. EPA was represented with three speakers: Laurence A. Bannerman spoke on future challenges, he presented the programme of the EPA congress in Turin and highlighted the changing

role of parking on its way from being a space to leave the car to becoming an urban mobility infrastructure. In the session "How do parking policies contribute to environmental policies" Antoni Roig reported from the experiences with the Barcelona Area Verda including the parking by the minute scheme whilst Peter Martens discussed "How to make parking and mobility policies work".
