## 16<sup>th</sup> EPA Congress in Dublin: September 11-13, 2013

The 16<sup>th</sup> EPA congress will take place from Wednesday September 11 to Friday September 13, 2013 in Dublin, Ireland. It is organized and hosted by the Irish Parking Association IPA.

Following the workmode developed for the 15th EPA congress in Turin the congress programme is set up by a Technical and Scientific Comittee which will determine the themes and speakers. The multinational, multiexpert team from a variety of backgrounds will ensure that parking is going to be further discussed within a broad context adressing both specialist perspectives and the context of urban mobility, new technologies and future trends.

Confirmed members to date for the Technical and Scientific Committee, chaired by Liam Keilthy, Ireland are Dr. Brian Caulfield (Dept. of Civil, Structural and Environmental Engineering, Trinity College Dublin), Simon Richardson (Dept. of Regional Development-Roads Services, Northern Ireland), Patrick Troy (CEO- British Parking Association), Brian Riddick (Dublin City Council / Irish Parking Association), Nick Lester (President EPA) and Gerhard Trost-Heutmekers (Secretary General EPA).

The congress venue is the Convention Centre in Dublin which provides an excellent professional and architectonically outstanding framework both for the scientific programme and the trade exhibition.

### **EPA General Meeting 2012 and EPA POLIS workshop**

# **Task Group Electronic Payments**

The task group examines the development of electronic payment systems and the impact for the parking industry. A proposal for next steps has been presented at the last EPA congress in Turin and meanwhile the first step of this proposal has been implemented.

EPA has established a contact to the IFSF, the Petrol Retail Industry Forum which has established standards recognized by the payment card industry. In the next few months the task group will investigate their model and learn from their experience to consolidate standards and processes. The next step will then be to investigate the feasibility of creating a processing platform at the European level which can process card payments for the parking industry at large (on and off-street), eventually in coherence with the IFSF schemes.



### **Guests to EPA Board Meetings**

The EPA board consists of five elected members. At the last EPA general meeting in Turin on September 16, 2011 the discussion arose to consider an enlargement up to eight members, in order to be able to ensure a better representation of more member countries. The invitation of guests during 2012 is to test the workability of this model and to consider a possible amendment of statutes.
