EPA Task group Blue Badge Parking in Europe



The scope and objectives for a new EPA task group on the subject matter of "Blue Badge Parking in Europe" has been distributed to the EPA members recently.

The "Blue Badge Scheme" was introduced in Europe to regulate exemptions from the parking regulations for disabled drivers.

The Blue Badge Scheme only applies for the public parking regulations and according to recommendation 98/367/EC badges issued in Member Countries must be accepted all member countries. The local regulations can be different and must be respected by the holder.

In many countries the badge gives the holder other rights, such as no charge at toll stations. It is reported that this fact lead to misuse of the blue badge. In some countries this is considered a big problem.

The objective of the EPA task group would be to discuss and identify issues concerning harmonization of regulations, harmonization of medical requirements and questions how to ensure security, validity and quality of the badges. The group will be chaired by EPA board member Egil Ostvik, NORPARK.

All EPA member associations are kindly invited to nominate interested members of their associations who would like to join and participate actively in this task group. The initial scope and brief document is available by request from the Secretariat.

The deadline for nominations is January 15, 2014.

Smart Urban Parking Strategies at POLIS annual conference




EPA board member Wilfried Thierry moderated the session on parking at the POLIS Annual Conference on December 4 , 2013 in Brussels.
