On the occasion of the IPI conference in Dallas a memorandum of understanding was signed by the following parking associations: Abrapark, Parking Australia, British Parking Association, Canadian Parking Association, European Parking Association, International Parking Institute to continue exchange and regular meetings.

EPA Key Messages brochure

EPA has published a printed brochure intended to help all members communicate consistently about the benefits of properly managed parking.

The messages are aimed mostly at supporting local authorities' communications on parking in a consistent manner in key areas such as urban development and accessibility, quality of urban public space, costs and allocation and finally environment and security. The work is based on the work of the EPA task group Image updated at the beginning of 2014. It is currently being published as a series of four articles in Parking Trend International, reproduced as brochure and available as pdf.

The ESPA is a standard for good quality in parking structures. The assessment and presentation of the ESPA awards is in the responsibility of the national parking associations.
