EPA Awards 2017



The EPA Award is a prestigious award established by the European Parking Association for excellence in parking. The awards are granted in five categories every two years at the EPA congress.

The deadline for entries is January 12, 2017. Please observe the rules and regulations which are available for download on the <u>EPA website</u> or by request from the EPA Secretariat.

The awards will be presented in a special ceremony during the 18th EPA Congress in Rotterdam, on September 20, 2017.

The objective of the awards is to promote qualitative improvements in public car parking both on- and off-street. The contributions of the parking operation to parking policy, to Sustainable Urban Mobility Plans and to urban development are important factors.

In particular the awards seek to promote improvements in services provided to the customers and effective and sustainable management of the facilities. The awards also promote the development of good working practices in on street parking.

EPA working Group: ESPA On-Street

The working group chaired by Antoni Roig is compiling a set of basic standards for on-street parking management.

It shall ensure the quality of service in regulated on-street controlled parking zones by establishing a set of minimum standards for a good basic quality in structure and services.

The documents are now available in draft form and will be used by be several test cities. The standard will subsequently be released in 2017 on the occasion of the EPA congress.

ESPA

The European Standard Parking Award ESPA is a standard for good quality in parking structures. ESPA Gold is for those car parks with high levels of customer services and comfort. To obtain the award the EPA provides a comprehensive excel checklist for download on the EPA website www.europeanparking.eu together with a manual to fill in the list. Members and operators are encouraged always to use the version provided on the website as the excel checklist is being maintained continuously and small bugs are fixed. The latest version is called ESPA checklist 1v23.

Each national member association in the EPA independently organises the procedure to award the standard to the operators or owners of the parking facility. The member associations may order the acrylic signs including mounting parts for 200,- € per piece and are asked to inform the Secretariat which car park has been awarded.
