


The issue: a captive market

Historical position in barriered car parks





- Equipment manufacturers have traditionally controlled all barrier parking payments due to a closed loop linkage between machines and opening and closure for entry and exit
- Previously no incentive to offer cashless payments as this simply diverted funds to a third party
- ParkBee's unique proprietary solution, incorporating both hardware and software, broke this cycle by enabling the barrier to be opened remotely
- Integrating the ParkBee solution with RingGo cashless payments in the UK provided quick and easy payments via a proven payment platform and expanded the reach and promotion of the solution










How it works for motorists

Leeds City Council uses RingGo and ParkBee to flag up staff parking areas to public

RingGo signage in a Leeds City Council car Leeds City Council is the first local authority to adopt a service offered by ParkBee and RingGo that opens up staff parking areas to the general public.

The council is opening up new spaces for locals and visitors and generating incremental income from an existing barriered parking site on Swinegate, which can only be accessed via the RingGo cashless parking app.

The solution allows the council to turn a staff-only car park into an area that the public can also use. ParkBee's technology allows motorists to enter the car park at the touch of a button and be charged automatically for the time they stay.

The staff car park is promoted in the RingGo app, and will be displayed if the driver is nearby or appearing with a special icon in the map function to enable motorists to clearly see that new spaces are available.

The RingGo and Parkmobile apps can now open barriers a ParkBee car parks The RingGo cashless parking payment service has launched a new feature that will enable its users to open the barriers of private parking spaces booked in the UK via the ParkBee online parking marketplace. ParkBee is already partnering with RingGo's sister brand Parkmobile in the Netherlands, where it has over 60 locations, and at 20 locations in the UK.

RingGo has been listing ParkBee sites without a barrier since April last year. It has now launched a new 'Start/Stop' feature that allows drivers to open barriers and gates through the parking app. This also changes the way customers are being charged, because their transaction starts when they enter the car parks and stops when they exit. RingGo users can also now make




Weekly ParkBee / RingGo sessions have grown steadily since inception in April 2018




RingGo - the UK's number 1 cashless parking solution
