EPA General Meeting 2018 New Board Members elected



At the EPA annual General Meeting 2018 in Prague five members of the Board were elected. Philip de Brabanter (Belgium) and James Toal (Austria) join the EPA Board. George Hadjigeorgiou (Cyprus), Michael Kesseler (Germany) and Stefan Sadleder (Austria) were re-elected.

The EPA Board now counts ten members.

In addition to the members mentioned above these are: Laurence A. Bannerman, President (Italy); Peter Dingemans, (Netherlands) and David Kownator (France). All have a term of office of two years, where five members are elected each year.

Michael Kesseler and Antoni Roig were re-elected as Vice Presidents.

Peter Dingemans and James Toal are representatives of the Associate members.

The next EPA General Meeting 2019 will be on September 20, 2019 in Malaga, Spain.

New EPA Statutes

The General Assembly in Prague passed substantial changes in the EPA statutes. EPA thus officially became the association representing the national professional parking and mobility related organisations in European countries.



New membership categories have been introduced:

Besides the existing Full Members and Associate Members EPA can from now on admit Institutional Members which represent national and international organisations with activity areas related to the parking and mobility context.

A further category established is reserved for International Affiliate Members which are international parking associations or organisations to be admitted as guest members.

The voting system for Full Members was simplified and there is now a clearer distinction between the responsibilities of the Board and the General Meeting.

The European Standard Parking Award ESPA is a standard for good quality in parking structures and on-street parking management.

ESPA Gold is for those car parks or on-street schemes with high levels of customer services and comfort. Each national member association in the EPA independently organises how to award the standard to the operators or owners of the parking facility. The member associations may order the acrylic signs including mounting parts for 200, - € per piece and are asked to inform the Secretariat which car park or on-street scheme has been awarded.
